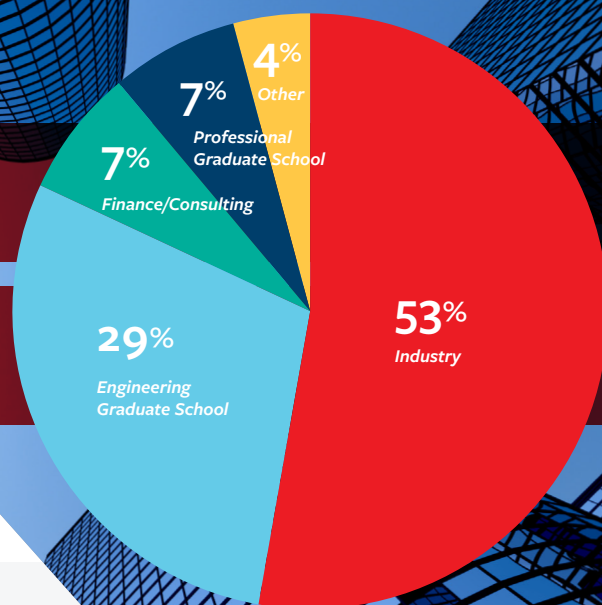




UNDERGRADUATE CAREER PATHS
